### Diagnosis

The clinical picture of rough appearance containing multiple reddish elevations on dorsal tongue does show some resemblances to hemangiolympangioma. However, on histologic pictures, no proliferation of blood vessels and lymphatic channels can be noted. Instead, a diffuse eosinophilic homogenous hyalination within the connective tissue stroma can easily be observed in this case.
